

History

- Toastmasters began as a series of speaking clubs organized by Dr. Ralph C. Smedley during his time working for the YMCA – Illinois, USA
- Dr. Smedley saw a need for the men in the community to learn how to speak, conduct meetings, plan programs and work on committees, and he wanted to help them
- The first unofficial Toastmasters meeting was held on March 24,
 1905
- The first official Toastmasters meeting was held on October 22,
 1924
